Really promising baby and very sound, super temperament, lovely feminine head, dark expressive eyes, ample forechest with correct length of leg, well made quarters, good coat texture. **Vintage B** (2) 1 Carley's Jupavia Arizona Jw Shcm. 12yrs. Super breed type, balanced head, mobile ears, lovely forechest and forelegs, neat feet, enough neck, good topline, strong quarters, moved soundly, shown in good coat. 2 Spurr's Dreamwork Interstellar. 11yrs. Red/white, another good breed type, super temperament and very sound free mover, enough bone and balanced body, correct tail carriage. **VB** (5) 1 Shahmatova's Nashdom La Vie Est Belle Jw. Very feminine with lovely head and expression, straight front and good feet, could have a little more forechest and neck, good topline and ribs, super quarters and sound, shown in lovely coat and condition. 2 Mead's Somniatis Harlee Quinn. Lovely breed type, pleasing head and mobile ears, straight front and good feet, ample bone, good neck and quarters just preferred topline on winner, showed well, close decision. 3 Dodd's Bordabears Be My Surprise At Molumiki Aw. **MPB** (2) 1 Milham's Elystari Million Dreams 2 lovely babies, super head and expressive eyes, well placed ears, when settled made a lovely clean outline, good front and rear construction with good bone and well made body, sound mover but handler could have moved her a little faster to see extension. Best Puppy Bitch. BOS Puppy. 2 Baxter's Wild Storm Tamita At Roseley (imp). Lovely baby still carrying her puppy fat, sweet head and good ear carriage, lovely bone and ribs, correct topline and tail set, strong rear pasterns, showed well, close decision. **PB** (1) 1 Elystari Million Dreams. **JB** (6) 1 Oliver's Tambuzi Guess Who's Back Jw. Lovely class. Super breed type, lovely head proportions with well placed ears and expressive eyes, straight front and neat feet, could have a shade more forechest, lovely neck into clean well placed shoulders, correct topline and well developed quarters, good tail carriage, sound with lovely profile movement. 2 Greening's Kanamaren Road To Joy. Another super breed type, pretty head, well placed ears and dark expressive eyes, lovely bone and feet, good lay of shoulder and neat elbows, well ribbed up with good topline and tail set, muscled quarters, showed and moved well. 3 Hawker's Taytinja Defying Gravity. **YB** (7). 1 Schevenels / De Cree's Broadmeadows Jaz-O-Mine. Lovely class, just thought winner was slightly more feminine, lovely head and expression, super front construction, ample bone, good neck and topline, well ribbed back, correct slope towards tail, strong quarters, showed well. 2 Lee's Jaybob Child's Play Jw Bigger mold but very balanced, correct head shape, well placed ears, shade full in eye, lovely neck and shoulders, super body and stifles with strong rear pasterns, showed well in super

condition, very close decision. 3 Hawker's Taytinja Defying Gravity. **NB** (5). 1 lystari Million Dreams. 2 Hawker's Taytinja Shooting Star. Pretty feminine head, mild expression, enough bone and neat feet, ample neck, good topline and spring of rib, well bent stifles, a shade wide in front movement but lovely side gait. 3 Spurr's Dreamwork Notorious. **GB** (4). 1 Taytinja Shooting Star. 2 Alison's Wenmap Topkapi Gem. Not as feminine in head as winner, well placed mobile ears, and nice eye shape and colour, ample bone, good length of neck and muscular, correct length of body and spring of rib, moderate bend of stifle, not topline of winner, moved well. 3 Lewis's Shemella To The Moon And Back. **PGB** (5). 1 Lewis & Lewis's Shemella Misty Morning. Carrying top weight but showed and moved well, handler got the best out of her, pleasing head and ears, good front and feet, enough neck, well sprung ribs, correct topline and tail carriage, moderate quarters, strong rear pasterns. 2 Wenmap Topkapi Gem. 3 Chatee's Calareto Wild Honey Pie. **LB** (9) 1 Green & Ratcliffe's Arroddare Fire It Up. Very feminine, balanced head with correct ears and dark eye, ample forechest, straight forelegs, well ribbed up with correct topline and sloping quarters. Super rear construction, shown in good coat and condition, moved with drive. 2 Yvonne Welch's Simmovon Reason Too Dream Jw. Strong bitch, different type to winner but close decision. Balanced head and body, ample bone with correct front and rear pasterns, enough neck, well made body, good quarters, shown in excellent coat and condition. 3 Hawker's Moshanta Magic Penny For Taytinja. **OB** (10). 1 Fawcett's Laceway Breaking Waves. Not a small girl but very balanced, lovely head and keen expression, lovely front assembly with ample neck straight front and neat feet, good forechest, strong topline and good spring of rib, super muscled quarters, and very sound free mover, shown in lovely condition. Pleased to award her RCC. 2 Green & Ratcliffe's Sh Ch Fayken I Am Here Jw. Lovely bitch with correct balance all through, good head and correct eye shape, super front and rear construction, solid body, correct topline, very sound, close dec. 3 Oliver's Sh Ch Tambuzi Girlz On Fire Jw. **Any Other Colour OB** (11). 1 Lewis & Lewis's Shemella Shepherds Delight. Blue bitch, good ears, a little full in eye, pleasing front and ample forechest, correct feet, carrying top weight made her look a little stuffy in neck, balanced outline, strong quarters and very sound. 2 Fawcett's Janbell Out Of The Blue At Laceway. Blue Merle Of good colour, showed well just preferred head on winner, balanced outline, lovely front assembly, ample neck with good topline and well bent stifles. 3 Dodd's Molumiki Down In Upendi. **Special Working B** (3). 1 Molumiki Down In Upendi. Good breed type, pleasing head and eye, enough bone, tight feet, balanced outline but carrying top weight, good topline when settled, moved well. 2 Kathryn Milham Elystari This Must Be Love Jw. Lovely breed type just preferred movement of winner, preferred head and topline on this bitch, good quarters and profile movement, shown in good coat, close decision. 3rd. Miss W Alison's Zeabo Yankee Girl (imp) It. **Special Members OB** (7). 1 Green & Ratcliffe's Sh Ch Fayken I Am Love Jw. 9 yrs old and looking fantastic, very sound free mover, loved her head and expression, very balanced all through, super front construction excellent forechest, forelegs and correct

spring of pasterns, strong neck of correct length, excellent shoulders and return of upper arm, good bone, super well knit body of correct length, strong topline and loin with well bent muscled rear, parallel hocks, shown in super coat and condition. BCC and was awarded BIS. 2 Lee & Ratcliffe's Sh Ch Arrodare Showdown Jw. Another lovely bitch, sweet head and mild expression, balanced all through, enough bone, clean outline, good straight front, not forechest of winner, lovely topline and quarters, very sound and shown in tiptop condition. 3 David Kinton's Kinaway Kisses With Fire (ai).
